What is Community Transport?



Community transport offers safe, accessible, cost-effective, flexible transport run by the community for the community.

Most of us take it for granted that we will be able to get the places we need to. However, when people can't drive or access public transport, they can be left stranded.

Community transport offers a lifeline in rural and urban areas, helping those who find it difficult to access other transport.

Across Oxfordshire, many groups offer community transport services, including:

- Volunteer car schemes
- Door-to-door minibus services
- Group transport for voluntary organisations
- Scheduled minibus services

Community transport services are not for profit, but may make small charge to cover costs such as fuel. Most services rely on volunteers.
