CONNECTED COMMUNITIES FUND

Groups supported in 2023/2024

The Connected Communities Fund aims to create opportunities for socialising and building meaningful connection by increasing the number of activities available for older people and adults with additional needs. We do this by encouraging grassroots initiatives to access flexible funding alongside an ongoing package of support. This "grants-plus" approach is delivered in partnership by Oxfordshire Community Action and Community First Oxfordshire and is funded by Oxfordshire County Council.

Now running for a second year, in this round of the programme we have supported 62 community groups and organisations with grants ranging from £450 to a maximum of £5000. Since launching in 2022 we have distributed £350,000 to 104 groups supporting over 119 projects and activities to run across Oxfordshire.
